After graduated the University of Zilina, specialisation “Track maintenance and reconstruction of railway lines” in 1963 started my work for former the Czechoslovak State Railways (CSD), later the Czech Railways (CD):

- 5 years – Railway engineer at a regional railway maintenance unit with focus to track maintenance ;
- 20 years – Railway Direction in Prague, in the Civil Engineering Section as a railway superstructure specialist;
- 9 years – CD - General Direction, Civil Engineering Department as a civil engineer for railway superstructure, Head of technical section, Technical Deputy Director and Director, cooperation with UIC, CEN and AREMA;
- 10 years – CD - General Director’s Office as an adviser for railway interoperability and CD participation in the European railway research projects under EU Framework programmes FP5 – FP7, e.g. InteGRail, Innotrack etc.;
- 2 years part-time job for VUZ (Railway Research Institute) as an adviser for railway interoperability and participation in railway research projects;
- 11 years up to the end of October 2019 – ACRI - Association of Czech Railway Industry as Technical Manager (railway interoperability and technical standards, cooperation with UNIFE).
